Goals and characteristics

The Fellow will be given the opportunity to learn basic science concepts, history and physical examination aspects, diagnosis, nonoperative and operative treatment, and rehabilitation of knee, hip, and shoulder problems, especially related to athletes. The Fellow will also be exposed to other areas of sports medicine, including sports trauma, spine, hand, foot, and ankle. There are 2,500 cases per year. There will be a four-month knee rotation, a two-month shoulder rotation, a two-month general sports medicine rotation, a two-month hip rotation, and a two-month research rotation. Surgery encompasses both open and arthroscopic techniques. Care of sports teams will be a part of the fellowship. The clinic is also officially responsible for local high school teams, the United States Ski Team, and also assists with the Denver Broncos and the Colorado Rockies.

This fellowship opportunity is available to six Fellows.
